Surveyed Depths – Harwich Harbour

Mariners are advised that recent surveys have identified reduced depths in Harwich Harbour. The minimum depth is now 15.0m below Chart Datum in the harbour area between the Grisle Buoy and the Babergh Buoy. See chart extract below for further information.


Maintenance dredging works are currently underway to restore the navigable depth and a further notice will be issued once this work has been completed.

This notice replaces local notice to mariners No. 11 of 2024, which is now withdrawn.






